NIFTY – 24,246.70 (Daily Chart)



 In Thursday's trading session, the Nifty opened on a negative note and traded in a sideways manner, oscillating within a narrow band of 24,240–24,300. The session lacked decisive momentum and eventually ended with a negative close, suggesting consolidation after a strong recent uptrend.

• On the daily chart, a small red candle has formed, indicating a range-bound session. This reflects exhaustion in bullish strength and a possible pause or pullback, especially after several consecutive positive closes. The RSI has started to tilt southward from the overbought zone, hinting at slowing bullish momentum.

• For Friday's trading session, 24,200 will act as an initial support level and, on the higher end, 24,270 will act as an initial resistance level.

BANK NIFTY – 55,201.40 (Daily Chart)



• In Thursday's trading session, the Bank Nifty moved in a flat range for most of the day, showing signs of indecision and consolidation. Toward the end of the session, however, the index drifted lower, resulting in a negative close.

• On the daily chart, a small-bodied candle with a wick on top has formed, signaling selling pressure at higher levels. This reflects hesitation among bulls to carry the rally forward after a strong up move in recent sessions. The RSI is gradually moving southward from the overbought zone, indicating a loss of bullish momentum and the possibility of further cooling off.

• For Friday's trading session, 55,100 will act as an initial support level and, on the higher end, 55,445 will act as an initial resistance level.











STOCK'S IN NEWS

IEX : The IEX reported a 21% year-on-year rise in net profit at ₹117.1 crore for the March quarter, compared to ₹96.7 crore a year ago. Revenue grew 17.25% YoY to ₹142.2 crore, while EBITDA rose 16.1% to ₹121.3 crore. Operating margin stood at 85.3%, slightly lower than 86.2% in the same quarter last year.

RITES : The state-run railway infra major, on Thursday said it has received a work order worth ₹28 crore from Mahanadi Coalfields Ltd (MCL) for detailed engineering & project management consultancy services.

CYIENT : The IT firm posted a 46% sequential jump in net profit at ₹186.4 crore, driven by improved margins and operating performance. EBIT rose 5.2% QoQ, while EBIT margin expanded to 12.3% from 11.6%. Revenue dipped marginally to ₹1,909.2 crore. The board has recommended a final dividend of ₹14 per share.

SBICARD : SBI Card on Thursday reported a 19 per cent decline in profit to ₹534 crore in the March quarter, on account of a rise in defaults. Pure-play credit card company, promoted by SBI, SBI Cards and Payment Services Ltd (SBI Card) had earned a profit of ₹662 crore in the fourth quarter of the previous fiscal.

ECONOMIC NEWS

- US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent has said he expects India to strike the first bilateral trade deal to avoid President Donald Trump's reciprocal tariffs, according to the New York Post. A 26 per cent 'reciprocal' tariff on Indian exports to the US is currently on a 90-day pause, set to expire on July 8. However, like other countries, India is presently subject to a 10 per cent tariff under the existing policy.
- The government is working to reduce the regulatory issues in the logistics sector to enhance ease of doing business, and attract more investments, a senior government official said on Thursday. Addressing an event here, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) joint secretary Pankaj Kumar said discussions are underway to make the PM Gati Shakti data more accessible to the private sector.
